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真正的敬拜不局限於一件事、一個形式,或者一個地方,卻是讓敬拜成為信徒的一種生活形態:一種凡事都因愛耶穌基督而有的自然表現。在崇拜裡,我們愛慕上帝在聖約裡的掌權,並屈膝在祂終極的主權下,經驗上主的同在。Louie Giglio 是 "Passion Worship (盡情敬拜)"的創辦人,他描述:「敬拜神就是對神在我們日常生活中所賜與的恩典有所回應,奧妙的不是我所唱頌的詩詞,而是我自己:『我是你腳下的祭品,腳踏美麗的旋律,我整個人都要讚美祢!』」

在集體敬拜裡,人需要被帶領,崇拜領袖就是帶領會衆進入敬拜。熱情有動力的崇拜領袖雖然可以激勵我們稱頌讚美神,但是每個敬拜者的靈都必須獨自回應神的靈:倘若人的心沒有對準神,無論如何被激勵也沒法進到敬拜。所以敬拜者務必先學習開放心懷,隨著聖靈的帶領,對這位創造主有正確的敬拜和回應,才能達到「盡心、盡性、盡意、盡力愛主你的神。」(可12:30)

位於美國鄉鎮的衛理公會Ginghamsburg教會充滿著神的靈澆灌,有如昔日初期教會五旬節的經歷。負責敬拜的 Mike Slaughter 牧師深知道,信徒與主耶穌的個人關係會直接影響他們對社會群體的承擔:地方教會的重任就是促進個人生命的改變,以致整個國家和世界得以改善。這間教會每周有超過六千人參加教會活動,但是令敬拜牧師最感到高興滿足的,是那些勇於改變並盡力敬拜的信徒,他們不單在家庭中有承擔,更願意踏出教會,往普世去傳揚主愛。

從教會三萬六千平方尺偌大的青年館的設計中,我們可以看見敬拜牧者對年青一代的關注。這裡有不同刺激感觀的敬拜,藉著各種不同高科技媒體講述神的故事,配合不同風格的音樂元素,吸引不同族裔而多元化的青年社群,齊集一起高聲宣告神的名。Mike Slaughter牧師有五本著作\*,講述他對徹底性信心運動的心得。

Ginghamsburg教會自1863年創立,教會領袖早已明白教導的重要,並於1979年前已培訓超過50位傳道人,差派他們到不同的工場:這些年青傳道人影響了很多人的生命,一直傳承至今。這間教會專心領人去教會認識主,並建立他們,然後差派他們到世界各地宣教工場。這三個藍本和步驟與城北華基教會多年來的口號不謀而合:「領他們、得建立、蒙裝備、差出去(Bring them in, Build them Up, Train them Well, Send them Out!)。

至於教會敬拜設計者 Kim Miller 的使命是:「以創新的敬拜方法,幫助人與主耶穌結連」,她認為每周的教會崇拜是最合適的場所,並總結每周的敬拜是:

- 1. 最佳的場合,讓跌倒的人與救贖的神相遇。
- 2. 最佳的環境,讓社區的人互相認識及連繫。
- 3. 最佳的安排,讓信心運動新方向得以展開。
- 4. 最佳的氣氛,讓信心群體反思核心價值觀。
- 5. 最佳的機會,讓迷失群羊認識慈愛大牧人。

祝願我們學效有美好敬拜的教會作榜樣,讓神帶領我們 以合 一的心服侍祂。

當然那完全只是構想,不過我相信每間華基教會的領袖都盡力用不同方式,帶領信徒在敬拜中經歷神。在歷史每個重大轉變,都始於相應的革新建築設計及科技進步。當教會探討如何策劃事工配合現代化之際,我們必須為尋找屬靈滿足的人提供有效的創新連接點,促進「高科技、高接觸」事工,讓更多不同背景及經歷的人來認識主耶穌。我鼓勵信徒有機會參加不同的崇拜聚會,經歷不一樣敬拜神的感受。

我們說去中國的短宣是「 交流」,確是十分貼切的事。交 流有互相學習、彼此造就的意 思。每次我在中國事奉,領唱詩 歌或做敬拜讚美的培訓,自己都 大得幫助。中國内地信徒的唱詩 敬拜是熱情的、盡情地頌唱。他 們無論是否懂得那首詩歌,人人 都會開口,而且高聲地唱,興奮 熱切、全情投入,毫無忌諱。今 天很多中國的教會都很大,聚會 時人數衆多,當衆人都揚聲讚美 時,聲浪澎湃,往往把主領敬拜 者和伴奏樂器的聲音都蓋過。從 他們的敬拜中,我體會到敬拜者 應當對神的尊崇和擺上。

我們常有一個錯誤的觀念, 認為自己在先進發達、文明自由 的社會生活,必定比沒有宗教自 由的中國信徒更懂得敬拜,所以 要回去幫助他們、教導他們。或 者我們在頭腦的知識上比他們豐 富、在敬拜的模式上比他們開

放;然而,很多北美華人信徒的唱詩敬拜 都比不上他們有生命力。我在本地教會崇 拜中,往往只看到一半、甚至更少人是認 真地唱詩,很多人都表現十分冷淡,只是 偶而動動口、隨便輕聲唱唱; 有些人甚至 閉□觀看,一點都不參與。我常收到有人 給意見說教會音響太大聲,其實都因為會 衆音量太小;相比在國内,卻只擔心音響 不夠響亮。

願我們放下各樣的重擔,盡情高歌 頌讚神,「因耶和華為大,當受極大的 讚美。」(代上16:25;詩96:4)。我們如此 事奉(敬拜),乃是理所當然、無可指責 的。

## 放射治療室的讚美

十年前發現患癌,要接受30多次放射療程。每次在放射治療 室要停留20至30分鐘,臉部被一個面具壓著,四肢不能搖動,那 種感覺很難受;聽著機械不斷運作的輥轆聲,是無名恐懼的「禍」 吾躁聲。

我是音樂治療師,一天突發奇想。得到治療師的准許,我每天 帶著錄音機進入放射治療室,安排好要播放錄音帶的位置和音量, 然後把錄音機放在架上,插上電源,便躺在病床。治療師將我安頓

妥當後,他離開房間前,替我按下開關鈕,音樂便 播放出來。

我選擇的音樂都是一些安靜的敬拜詩歌,美妙 的音樂還遮蓋了機器操作聲。在特製的面具下,我 内心平靜安穩,有時心裡跟著詩歌哼唱、有時在優 美的音韻下,我默想、讚美,數算主的恩典;我心 裡要唱歌敬拜主,向主禱告,與主耶穌對話,享受 以馬内利的經歷。20分鐘瞬息即過,放射治療不再 是一個「忍受」,乃是另一種「享受」,是不一樣 真真實實的敬拜讚美。



## 擁戴神威榮

每周敬拜能否取悅神,取決於整個團隊對崇拜的心態。 《瑪拉基書》形容神難受的極低點,「甚願你們中間有一人 關上殿門,免得你們徒然在我壇上燒火。萬軍之耶和華說: 我不喜悦你們,也不從你們手中收納供物。」(1:10)神一 方面極期盼人前來敬拜,另一方面受不了他們從帶領到參 與,都是有名無實地一邊做敬拜的動作,一邊羞辱神的名, 神要把祂的殿門也關了!《啓示錄》從第4 章打後形容敬 拜,是天上神所享受的敬拜。我們每主日的崇拜,就因著帶 領崇拜者的領導而聚集行這敬禮,將神的榮耀彰顯刻劃,在 高到低點的線上達到某一處。

我所追求看見是領導崇拜的團隊能幫助敬拜者在過程中,心靈與神深深相會相通,以謙卑順服、誠心擁戴神的威

榮,誠心地數算神恩:並懷著順服的心聆聽神的心意,以身心靈、物質奉獻和口所出的詩歌頌詞去敬拜祂。神因為會衆這樣以愛以敬來親近,祂得著榮耀和喜悅。我相信結果就是神因為喜愛祂子民的敬拜而賜恩祝福,將各樣美好的恩典,厚賜與以誠以靈敬拜的會衆:其恩典之大,更會感染不懂誠心敬拜的旁人。

我認為敬拜的帶領團隊特別重要,我們團隊各人在選詩歌、經文、衣服鞋襪,甚至細至頭飾香水,都應以主的喜愛為念,不應該有一刻尋求自我喜悅,一切都在禱告中尋求主:在周間就要預備將主權交給主,參與時就一直建立神的榮耀。其次,屬靈成熟的會衆也應學習放棄自我的要求,不是為求來教會"拿"到甚麼,而是專注於來"獻"禮獻祭。會衆一周生命中所結的屬靈果子,應自己牢記,並帶來在敬拜和禱告中,一起獻上自己生活的活祭,一起立志另一周過合神心意的美好生活。我相信這樣的敬拜,真能把神的實在與威榮宣告出來,榮神益人!

我喜歡音樂,喜歡聽歌。末信主前聽的都是流行歌曲,信主後開始接觸聖詩。初信時,因為在地方教會聚會,唱的都是傳統聖詩,每次聚會,就是一個帶領弟兄在前面,一個司琴,然後會衆輪流憑著聖靈感動,點歌!點到那一首,可以不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不不。我當時信主不久,覺得還蠻有意思:不管會不會唱,只要歌點出來,衆人就張口大聲跟著唱、學著唱、讚美神!

工才做完工,挺累的,還沒收拾 完,我們就站在空地上等他們。他 們陸續從住的地方出來,圍了一張 小板凳,大家就坐下查經分享,然 後唱詩敬拜神。還記得那天,他們 要我教他們唱詩。沒有任何樂器 伴奏、和音,我就用自己那想大聲 唱、又唱不大的聲音,清唱了一遍 《生命的執著》。在中東的戶外, 晚上不太熱,燈光有些昏暗,抬頭 就是夜空,這首詩歌卻抓住了每個 **人的心**。我感覺不管誰在領唱、誰 的聲音是否好,大家都輕輕跟著唱 起來:「祢是我心中,我心中惟一 的詩歌,我要向口盡情的歌唱,向 祢獻上最真誠的愛…」透過歌詞和 旋律,我們都感受到神的同在,有 一些暖流在我們當中,唱著唱著, 神深深的平安流下,流淌在我們心 中,告訴我們不管有甚麼遭遇和難 題,都能被神的愛勝過,有信心去 。 樸面

Have you ever frowned upon the mother who brought her toddler into the Sanctuary for worship service? The child was nice and quiet for a total of five minutes and then became restless. Have you sat next to a distracted woman who had a big bag full of stuff and seemed unkempt? That mother might have been me or one of my comrades, I mean, mothers-in-training.

For the past three years since my child was born, attending worship service has become a luxury. As a new mother, our primary task is to care for our baby. So we go to the nursery on Sundays so that our babies can be in the playroom and that we can nurse/feed/ change diapers promptly when required. We graduate to become toddlers and can go to the toddler room for circle time with stories and snacks. But honestly, I can do all these at home, or at a playgroup. There really isn't a need for me to pack up the diaper bag and the kid, rush out the door on Sunday morning to get to church.

Hence, we sneak into the Sanctuary for a glimpse of the worship service. We want to feel again what it's like to be in a corporate worship setting. We want to sing out loud and hear the Sunday sermon. We want to pray with the whole congregation.

We are called motherhood have found ourselves more broken than ever. We have never found ourselves so worried about another human being (the kid) nor so frazzled because there really isn't enough time to get everything done. We have found fewer and fewer answers to questions we have about motherhood, life and God.

The additional title of "mother" to my name has brought on a whole new meaning to "worship". True, I can worship anywhere, anytime, but it simply isn't the same. I crave the time that I can sit in the Sanctuary with the congregation and just be there. I yearn for the moment when tears roll down because a song has touched me deeply, and not just tears of exhaustion. I long for the "ah-ha" moment when the pastor's words bring upon enlightenment.

And so, we go to the Sanctuary. Sometimes the toddler just doesn't want to be left in the toddler's room. So we bring the kid along. Do you think we don't know that we are disrupting the nice and quiet worship service environment that Chinese churches have incubated? Sure we know, but the bible said, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." (Matt 11:28)



My name is Shu-Ling Lee and I'm one of the English Congregation Pastors at Richmond Hill Christian Community Church. I want to share a bit about where I come from, how I came to faith in Jesus Christ and how I felt the call to God's ministry.

I was born and raised in Toronto and have lived in the city of Markham for most of my life. My parents brought me and my brother to Toronto Chinese Baptist Church, where I'm indebted to numerous friends, "uncles and aunties", Sunday school teachers, and fellowship counsellors who have helped shape my faith in the early vears.

Fast forward to the Billy Graham Crusade in 1995. I remember being invited to a preceding event called "Go M.A.D. (Make A Difference)" which became the place where I first responded to the gospel message of forgiveness and restoration in my life. It was there I decided to dedicate my life to Jesus as Lord and Saviour and my life's mission to help direct others to Him.

During my years in high school, I deeply wrestled with academics and almost gave up getting into university. I definitely did not "get what I wanted" and I actually got rejected to every university program I applied to! I considered going straight to bible college for full-time ministry as I thought about my future. Thankfully, my pastor at TCBC, Rev. Nolan Lee, counseled and encouraged me to put more effort in my academics and continue to apply to a

university so I could learn how to engage people "in the real world". More specifically, he wanted me to learn how different people in society actually engage and think about faith and life. After improving my school marks over that summer, I ended up getting accepted to York University. I graduated 4 years later, also serving in York CCF (Chinese Christian Fellowship) as Chairperson during my time there.

After university, I prayed and asked God if it was still His direction for me to pursue seminary and perhaps become a pastor. During this time, my friend and mentor, Rev. Ken Foo (Mississauga Chinese Baptist Church), shared with me his call to ministry and I remember God similarly tugging at my heart after hearing his story. After various signs and affirmations from my church and fellowship community, I ended up applying to Tyndale Seminary and have since graduated (2010) with an M.Div. in Worship & Liturgy. I believe that as part of His sovereign plan, God also provided a part-time job as the Celebration (Worship) co-ordinator of the RHCCC's English Congregation which eventually evolved into the Celebration Pastor position. In 2015-16, I have also been asked to take up pastoral leadership of our Cultivation (Small Groups) Ministry.

In June of 2013, I began my doctoral studies (D.Min) in Missional Leadership at Northern Seminary in Chicago, IL. Who would've ever thought a person who didn't even have the grades to get into any university program would end up doing his doctoral studies over a decade later? God works in mysterious ways! Over the years, I have felt God developing a passion in me to connect Sunday Worship with missional living for His church for the rest of the 6 days of the week. As much as I loved leading worship and mentoring new worship leaders and worship bands, I realized that building a worshipful community also required building a discipling community that desires to make disciple-makers for Jesus! In my ministry in particular, I noticed that 2nd Generation Chinese-Canadians may have understood

and accepted the gospel message of salvation of sins, but basically not grasped the wider implications of the GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM that Jesus proclaimed so often in the gospel writings. The Kingship of Jesus is both important eternally and presently! I personally believe that there has to be a movement of cross-cultural discipleship within the Chinese church that can help disciple 2nd generation Christians to become disciple-makers themselves! Some of these core issues will be addressed in my upcoming doctoral thesis and I hope it can benefit the local Chinese churches somehow.

Lastly, I truly thankful for God's amazing grace in my life. In school, in relationships with family and friends, in my ministry, God has shown His fingerprints all over my life. I have not always got what I wanted, but I've realized that God has given me much more than I could have ever imagined. He's given me a greater purpose in life and I see Him as Jehovah Jireh, "the Lord is my provider". I'm learning to live against my natural, entitled and consumeristic mindset and I am trying to show people the "kingdom way" of selflessness, generosity and love. I am grateful for RHCCC and all those who have walked with me through the mountains and valleys of life together. I want to thank the leaders of ACEM and RHCCC for affirming my call to ministry and I am happy to share that I will be ordained as a Reverend on Nov 19 at RHCCC.

As a leader in God's church, I pray I can continue to stay humble, be gracious and continue to invite others into the Kingdom of our Saviour King, Jesus Christ.

I am married to my patient and loving wife, Monica, and we have two little gifts from God: Matthias (4) and Aaliyah (1).

I want to end off my article with these words: "You don't always get what you want in life... but I thank God that Jesus and His Kingdom is more than enough." 家

# 中國留学生事工异象分享

## 瀑布区福音中心 (Niagara Region Gospel Center)

总是在不经意间从你身边偷網走,还没摸到神学的網摆,三年多在加神的神学学习一下子就结束了。整整三年半,全时间的读书和工作,使我深深地体会到主耶稣曾说的那句话:"一个人不能事奉两个主,不是恶这个爱那个,就是重这个轻那个。你们不能又事奉神,又事奉玛门。"(太6:24)感谢主的恩典与眷顾,神学一毕业,就找到了事奉的工场:瀑布区大学校园的中国留学生福音事工。

过往10年,每年抵加的留学生数量有10-12%的戏剧性增长。加拿大政府正致力于引进更多的留学生来此学习深造\*,而中国留学生是加拿大国际留学生的稳定来源;加国新公布的移民政策也鼓励这些留学生毕业后,在加国工作并最终移民定居。有鉴于此,中国留学生正如浪潮般高中学校。仅瀑布区就已有超过2,000多名中国留学生就读于两个大专院校。禾场之广大,令人兴奋;相信神正兴起祂的工人准备收割。可以说,今后10年至20年最具策略性的福音事工,就是为基督赢得这世代的华人知识分子,途径就是校园宣教!

当我和太太把这看见和想法与城北堂植堂部主任岑甘葳玲牧师分享时,她给予了我们极大的支持和帮助。经过一年多时间的考察,城北堂植堂部很认同这是福音的据点,愿意承担这项建立神国度的圣工,并得到华基联会植堂部的部份經費资助。今年8月,我们被差派正式走人事奉工场,一家搬到瀑布区,开始建立「瀑布区福音中心」的工作。

一踏入工场,我们就看到神的手在动工: 距我们第一次的学生聚会至今,刚刚两个半月,每周一次共11次的团契时间,学生人数已从第一次的5个人增长到20人。到目前为止,已有7人决志信主,其中3人在感恩节参與了華基瀑布堂的受洗。

目前,瀑布區福音中心的团契聚会已渐趋稳定,已建立了同工团队和敬拜小组。我们的事奉理念是:要切实地关怀学生,融入他们的生活,帮助他们解决生活中的实际困难。借每周一次的爱宴团契查经分享,及每月一次的外来讲员主题分享,与他们的学习、生活相结合,借此建立彼此之间的关系,并最终引导他们认识真理,渴慕真理。

在欢喜快乐为主收割庄稼的同时,我们也感到工人的缺乏。由于学生工作是撒种,完全付出而回报少的事工,很多教会没有足够的精力、人力、财力投入这项事工中。感谢主,在这当中我们经历主的带领和母会的支持!

由于学生居住在不同的区域,大部分的学生需要交通接送,还有每周一次的爱宴,随着学生人数的增加,可以预见接送学生和爱宴预备将成为一项大的挑战。感谢主,已有瀑布堂和城北堂的兄姐愿意不定期参与交通接送和爱宴的事奉。

"看哪,我告诉你们:举目向田里观望,庄稼已经成熟,可以收割了!" (约4:35),可是"要收的庄稼多,做工的人少。所以,你们当求庄稼的主,打发工人出去收他的庄稼。"(路10:2)

今天,中国留学浪潮席卷着加拿大各个高校!福音的庄稼已熟,并生长到我们的阶前!邀请您和我们一起同工,务要在这关键的时刻,深入校园,成为莘莘学子的梦想导师,引领他们进入耶稣基督荣耀的国度!诚邀有负担的弟兄姐妹参与本地留学生宣教事工!

God opposes the proud but shows favour to the humble." (James 4:6) It was a humbling experience for the Kenya PEACE team to walk in the land of Kenya this year from July 31 to Aug 11. We were providing pastoral training to 140 pastors and ran children's day camp for 500 children in partnership with the Changing Times Ministry (Kibera slum) and Mumias, West Kenya. During this time, the construction team was building various cooking stoves for the residents while the others were making home visits to share the gospel story and give out supplies to the widows and their children

• Sharing resources - Each day we provided 500 meals to the residents in the Kibera slum. We also collected a lot of clothing and medication and distributed out to the needy. The children were very grateful for our contributions and each child treasured every spoonful of food that they were given.

- Kibera slum The living condition in the slum has not been changed at all. We were strolling along the garbage filled, muddy paths, carrying bags of rice, cooking oil, sugar, soap, matches, and cookies to the households. In return, we are blessed by the widows. A lot of them were very sick but they still managed to make soap and tailor clothes for others. We were very amazed by the neighbours who generously offered to take care of each other. I observed that in poverty, the Kibera residents seem to live selflessly and share with each other despite their limited resources. Their actions are a learning lesson for us.
- Pastoral training I am also very touched by the pastoral training. The pastors have to walk for many hours to the training site. However, they tried their best to learn despite their exhaustion. I am also very impressed by the interpreters who are very knowledgeable but humble to learn from us.
- Changing Times High School It is all by faith that our church, RHCCC is able to engage in this kingdom work – to build a high school for the F1 to F4 students. The Changing Times Ministry originally has an elementary school in Kibera which consists of 420 children. As the teenagers are going through puberty, the risk of being abused increases. Pastor George Okoyol and his team asked the Lord to deliver the grownups from the pits and falls. In 2011, a widow approached the church and sold her piece of land to exchange for money. This piece of land is blessed and provided space for the school and pastoral training center. The Changing Times High School and training
- centre is to help the students continue their secondary school education and to provide vocational trainings for those who cannot go on to university. The building can also nurture the spiritual growth of pastors and Christian leaders. The farm land will provide agricultural and dairy products to feed the children and staff. Some produce can be sold to generate income. As we stepped into the land, we were filled with anticipation. We were amazed by the big halls and classrooms. We heard the joyful noise from the water machine. We also saw six cows being fed on the field. We foresee the birthing of the next generation on this piece of land. The Lord is using this Changing Times High School to cultivate the next tier of disciples and servant leaders.
- Lessons learnt Furthermore, we learnt to trust in corporate prayer and be accountable and supportive to each other. The team members were eager to approach and invite prayer warriors (4 prayer partners for each member) and continued to pray for us before and during the trip. Our prayer is asking the Lord to shape us to be compassionate listeners. We are listening to not listening for the needs of the pastors. Churches are facing extreme poverty, lacking resources, struggling with false doctrine, and being attacked by conflicts. The children, especially those who are at the stage of puberty, were being abused and detoured to the wrong path. We are humbled to listen to their stories. We are humbled to uplift the needy in the hand of our Heavenly Father. Amen. 家

## Seriously, can a short two weeks trip offer much help?

Since the trip in 2012, I felt that the help we offered during our short visit was very limited. I thank God for the eye-opening experience to partake in His Kingdom work, but the starving Kibera children would continue to starve after 2 weeks of free meal program. The sick would not be healed after 3 days of medical camp. Given the geographical distance. I felt like RHCCC/ACEM was applying a bandage to Kenya's deep wound.

God has changed my perspective during my second visit in 2016. Kenya as a country has improved and expanded. The airport is modernized; the roads between Nairobi and West Mumias have been paved. The government now distributes free condoms in support of birth controls. Changing Times ministry has changed a lot too! Children have newer school uniforms. The numerous holes in their school cardigans and patches on the torn dresses have disappeared. The "natural" classroom floor once padded with sand and rocks are now paved with tiles, stirring up much less dust as the students kneel on the ground to color their crafts. The boarding high school that is close to completion gives hope and a path to permanent solution to the children's future.

Maybe my two sparse visits did not contribute much help. We alone are weak and limited. But we are not alone. We are part of a team, a team that visits Kenya every year, and this team is led by God. ACEM/ RHCCC's support for Kenya does not end after the trip is over. With our partnership with Pastor George, God's work is continuous, year after year. His local steward Pastor George and his team carries out God's work every day, touching more lives with God's words than we have ever imagined. From a 2-weeks free meal program, and 3-days medical camp, our partnership with God has now expanded to partaking in year-round children sponsorship, building a boarding high school, equipping local servant leaders and supporting in church planting. God is a visionary. His plan is better than our plan. Each of us, or our short visit, is like one small dot. Together, we form a continuous line drawn towards God's Kingdom.

### Other Team members Reflection highlights:

- I did not feel compel to join a short-term mission because of my introvert personality and the gifts God had given me. God had opened my eyes and generously let me experienced Him. He could use anyone in His fabulous works.
- "Kenyan time" is a jargon familiar to all Kenya PEACE team members. The chicken is uncooked at 3pm when lunch is to be served at noon. Class should have started at 9:30am but the rain has kept the children from walking to the site. By the time they have arrived at 11am, it is time for tea break. After 2 hours of worships and encouragements at a Sunday service, the pastor finally begins to deliver today's main message. Kenyan culture can be quite different from Canada. Coming from a country that values punctuality, results and efficiency, we sometimes lose focus and compromised our passion and commitment to God and to others.
- 到了肯亞,眼看當地人民生活短缺 和貧乏,我心裡十分難過。有機會 探訪貧民區,瞭解他們飲用不潔食 水,有很多時候兩天才有飽飯吃, 居住環境十分惡劣,人人無所事 事,好像沒有盼望。
- 一班當地牧者不辭勞苦,從很遠的 地方走路幾小時來為要學習主的真 道進修和培訓,他們熱切追求主的 心,令我十分欣賞讚嘆!

- 超過400個小孩一起敬拜,讓我學 到人生很重要的一課,他們忘記貧 窮,饑餓。每天相聚敬拜時,他們 一同跳舞、唱詩,讚美主,他們充 滿熱情和熱切渴慕神的心,令我十 分感動,教我心裡火熱。
- 中午派飯時,看到孩子們無論多飢 餓,收到食物時,他們首先感謝讚 美神才進食。自問如果幾天沒有進 食,還能先禱告,或是第一時間把 食物放進中然後再感謝神呢?
- 看到教會為主建立的學校,萬分感 恩和讚美主所做的一切,「在人這 是不能的,在神凡事都能。」(馬 19:26) •
- 今次非洲短宣的體驗,不是用錢能 買到的,神常與我們同在,神的愛 遍滿全地,不分種族和國界。這世 上還有很多人需要上帝,除了要更 用心用力去敬拜主、積極人生、多 傳福音,我更會把短宣的經歷與別 人分享,鼓勵更多人一起參與,為 主作工,被主使用,盡一分的力。
- Mission with an impact is the goal – an impact for the one who serves and also for the one being served, for the one who has gone and also for the one who hasn't gone yet.
